

**Certificate Course in Korean Language (KP-1)**  
**Department of East Asian Studies**  
**University of Delhi**

**Course Duration: 150 hours**

**Course Description:**

This course provides basic knowledge of learning the Korean language, including the alphabet, to learn basic grammar, and equipping oneself with the new language and its cultural facts.

**Course Objectives:**

This course will help students:

1. To equip students with basic skills in reading, writing, speaking and listening in the Korean language.
2. To learn basic-level words, sentence structures, and phrases related to daily life in Korea.

**Course Outcomes:**

1. Students can gain familiarity with the basic level sentence structures and simple grammatical patterns.
2. It provides access to Korean culture and prepares them for further language study.
3. Students can participate in simple interactions and also access Korean resources.

**Course outline:**

- Formal and casual greetings, self-introduction
- Speaking declarative, interrogative, imperative and suggestive sentences
- Daily Schedule, School life, hobbies, weekend activities, counting units, money and time expressions
- Basic sentences regarding directions and boarding different means of transportation
- 4 seasons of Korea
- Telephonic conversation
- Basic expressions related to shopping, dining, hospital, bank, etc.
- Basic knowledge about Korean culture, history, politics and economy

### **Student Evaluation**

This course is a one-year program in a mode. It contains three papers, of which 2 are theory and one is a practical paper.

1. Script and Translation
2. Grammar, Comprehension and Essay
3. Audio-Oral Examination

The evaluation will be done in two phases. One is through internal examination, and the other is the final examination. Internal examination schedules for January/February and the final examination for April/May every year.
