Admission Procedure

- Mode of Admission :- Entirely online
- Application Portal:-https://cifl.oldcdu.ac.in/
- Application Window: 16 June to 12 July 2025
- Registration Fee:- Rs. 200 per course (nonrefundable)
- Documents Required:-
 - Photograph
 - Relevant mark sheets or certificates
 - Signature

General Eligibility Criteria

- The candidate must have passed the 10+2or equivalent examination.
- Merit Calculation: Marks of best four subjects (10+2), including English/Hindi, will be considered.
- Category-wise Eligibility*
- General Category: 50% in best four subjects with 45% in English/Hindi (whichever is higher).
- SC/ST/OBC/Others: 45% in best four subjects with 45% in English/Hindi (whichever is higher).

Additional Weightage

- Graduates in any discipline: +10% weightage
- Postgraduates in any discipline: +15% weightage

- Applicant's Name, Father's Name & Date of Birth must match the details in the Aadhar Card and Class 10th & 12th Marksheet/Certificate.
- Applicants can log in to the admission portal only through their registered email address and mobile number.
- Applicants must use their own active email ID and mobile number.
- The email ID and mobile number provided must remain functional throughout the admission process.

Important Instructions

- Applicants must submit all information carefully.
 Once furnished, no edits will be allowed.
- Merit lists do not guarantee admission—subject to verification of marks and original documents.
- Admission is merit-based and subject to availability of seats.
- Applicants must register only once. Multiple registrations will lead to disqualification.
- If applying for multiple languages, applicants must apply before uploading documents at the same time.

Additional Information

- No transfer between courses or sections is allowed after admission.
- All admissions are subject to verification of documents and eligibility.
- If at any stage, original documents are found to be fake, non-genuine, or fabricated, admission will be cancelled without prior notice. If discovered after course completion, the degree will be cancelled, and legal action will be taken.

Additional Information

- Note: Students enrolled in these courses are not entitled to regular student privileges such as library access, hostel facilities, etc. Identity cards will be issued, and an undertaking of compliance with college discipline is mandatory.
- Age Requirement:- No age bar for these certificate courses.
